School Parent and Family Engagement Policy [Graham County Schools] [2026-2027]

Parent and family engagement means the participation of parents in regular, two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring:

- o Parents play an integral role in assisting their child's learning,*
- o Parents are encouraged to be actively involved in their child's education at school,*
- o Parents are full partners in their child's education and are included, as appropriate, in decision-making and on advisory committees to assist in the education of their child, and*

- o Other activities are carried out, such as those described in Section 1116 of ESSA.*

- **Annual Title I Meeting**

- **Building Capacity of School Staff**

Robbinsville Elementary School will provide training to educate teachers, specialized instructional support personnel, principals and other school leaders, and other staff, with the assistance of parents, in the value and utility of contributions of parents, and in how to reach out to, communicate with, and work with parents as equal partners, implement and coordinate parent programs, and build ties between parents and the school by newsletters and parent teacher conferences. Robbinsville Elementary will provide parent nights to provide information such as state and student academic standards. The school will provide monthly home/school connection newsletters to each parent. Access to the National Parent Involvement Center will be made available to the families.

Robbinsville Elementary School provide opportunities for parents with limited English proficiency, parents with disabilities, and parents of migratory children by ensuring ESL translator will attend grade level parent meetings to help translate and ensure parent understanding. The ESL translator will attend any needed conferences or meetings to translate for parents.
