ABSTRACT

The latter is the only labeled heading within the abstract. Do not cite references or use abbreviations excessively in the abstract.

Keywords: five words maximum.

Competing interests

Explain in 1 or 2 sentences whether the author has no competing interests.

Author contributions

List the contributions of each author.

Example:

I.P.A.D. (author initials) is the sole author of this research article.

or

I.P.A.D. conceptualised and designed the study, acquired data, performed the statistical analysis and drafted the manuscript. J.T. and Y.D. participated in the data analysis and article writing.

Ethical considerations

Write down the ethical considerations of the research. Include ethics certificate numbers from ethics committees for research involving humans, animals, and the environment.

Example:

This article followed all ethical standards for research without direct contact with human or animal subjects

Ethical approval to conduct the study was obtained from the Your Institution (reference no. – Number ETC).

Funding information

Write down the source of research funding and research grant registration number.

Data availability

Explain the use of data in this research. It is necessary to mention if it uses data from other parties.
