## To Whom It May Concern:

The student applying for admission to your college or university has participated in the Frontier Early College program. Since his or her freshman year, this student has worked hard to earn the Indiana College Core Certificate (ICC) (formerly STGEC). Many of our students report that the Admissions Office at the college of their choice is unfamiliar with the ICC, so, in light of that, Frontier High School created this letter for students to include with their applications and to help with the transfer process.

The Indiana College Core was developed by the public institutions in Indiana in response to Senate Enrolled Act 182 of 2012. It allows a student who satisfactorily completes an approved program of general education at any public institution to transfer that coursework to another public institution as a block of 30 credit hours towards the general education core requirements.

At Frontier High School students are granted their ICC certificate through Ivy Tech Lafayette, our higher-education partner. The college credits our students earn come from dual-credit classes offered through Indiana University and Ivy Tech. The ICC pathway fulfills what is, generally, the freshman core for Indiana public colleges and universities, and all of the course's crosswalk through the listings on <a href="transferrin.net">transferrin.net</a>.

Moreover, a large number of private and non-Indiana colleges recognize the ICC and the dual credits of which it is composed. Students who complete all of their ICC coursework by the end of their senior year receive their certificate from Ivy Tech upon graduation. Frontier students know that it is their responsibility to have their Indiana University and/or Ivy Tech transcript(s) sent to your Registrar to verify their college-credits earned and completion of the ICC.
