# **NORCAL WINTER SERIES STOCK DOG TRIALS**

## **General Series Notes:**

This will be a sixth trial series, all held at the Ed Hughes Memorial Arena in Ione, CA.

Day money will be paid back in each class at each individual trial. (two trials per weekend)

There will be awards for the average winners for each two-trial (weekend) event in each class.

Buckles will be awarded for the Overall Series Champions and Reserve Champions in each class.

Must be the same handler/dog combination to compete for overall series awards. Points belong to the combination of handler and dog, not as individuals.

Series champions will be determined by the highest total score accumulated on 4 trials. If a handler/dog competes in more than 4 trials in the series, their best 4 scores will be added together to determine their placing.

Combined **time** on 4 trials will be used to break ties in overall score.

You do not have to compete in all six trials to be eligible for the series awards.

Series trial dates:

November 15- 16, 2025 Trial 1 & 2

January 10 -11, 2026 Trials 3 & 4

February 14-15, 2026 Trials 5 & 6

**\*\* Breakfast and lunch will be available for purchase on-site both days in November**

## **On-site Camping-RV's:**

There are no hookups- dry camping only.

The City of Ione has a **\$10.00 per night camping fee** that **MUST BE PAID IN ADVANCE THROUGH THE CITY OF IONE. YOU WILL NEED A CITY-ISSUED STICKER FOR YOUR VEHICLE, WHICH WILL BE SUBJECT TO VERFICATION BY LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT.**

**If you plan to camp at the trial, please send a separate check made out to the City of Ione, along with a completed Camping Permit Application. Mail your camping form in with your trial entry to Bill Dale.** We will take all of the applications and checks to the City of Ione to get stickers for those that register. We will have them available to hand out on trial weekend.

**WE CANNOT TAKE PAYMENT THE DAY OF THE TRIAL. PAYMENT AND FORMS ARE DUE NOVEMBER 7 WHEN THE ENTRIES CLOSE.**

## Camping Permit Application

**Camping is permitted only with prior approval from the Police Chief (209) 274-2412 ext. 108, and must be associated with a planned event at Howard Park, Evalynn Bishop Hall, or Ed Hughes Arena.**

- **Event organizers are responsible for collecting camping applications and fees**
- Applications can be submitted by event organizers to City of Lone staff at #1 East Main Street, Lone, CA.
- Mailed applications must arrive at City Hall at least **5 Days Prior** to the first day of stay. Send applications (with payment) to:

- Applications are not valid unless accompanied by payment.
- No campfires are allowed on park property except in those areas provided and designated for the purpose, such as public barbeques.
- Campers must obey all City of Lone Park and Camping Ordinances Section 12.6.030– 12.06.110 or otherwise may be asked to vacate the park by the Lone Police Department.
