Website	Description
The Cambridge History of English and American Literature	Contains over 303 chapters and 11,000 pages, with essay topics ranging from poetry, fiction, drama and essays to history, theology and political writing.
Voice of the Shuttle	Links to resources related to all areas of the humanities, including English, literature, history, literary theory, and music, emphasizing both primary and secondary (or theoretical) resources.
LibreTexts Humanities Library	LibreTexts provides user-friendly interactive textbooks and related materials. Bookshelves provides access to open access textbooks, and Learning Objects provides access to interactive materials, content items, practice items, and assessment items.
Internet Public Library Special Collections - Literary Criticism	Contains critical and biographical websites about authors and their works that can be browsed by author, by title, or by nationality and literary period.
