Master of Project Management - Minor in Ministry-Based Project Management

Course Duration: 2 years

Credit Hours: 69 (including 15 credit hours for minor)



Program Description

The Master of Project Management at HBI University is designed to equip students with advanced skills in project planning, execution, and strategic leadership. This program integrates risk management, financial oversight, stakeholder engagement, and operational planning to prepare graduates for leadership roles in corporate, nonprofit, and ministry-based project environments.

The Minor in Ministry-Based Project Management provides a specialized focus on faith-based leadership, resource management, and strategic development for church and ministry projects. Students will explore Christian leadership principles, effective ministry project execution, and financial sustainability strategies tailored for religious organizations, churches, and community outreach programs.

This 69-credit hour program includes 30 credit hours of foundational project management courses, 24 credit hours of core project execution and strategic planning courses, 15 credit hours in Ministry-Based Project Management, elective coursework, a supervised practicum, and a research-based master's thesis.

Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in business, management, or a related field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation from faculty or business professionals
- Statement of purpose outlining career goals in business, project management, and faith-based leadership
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- Interview with faculty committee (if required)

Practicum Requirement

Students must complete a 300-hour supervised practicum in corporate project execution, ministry leadership, or nonprofit project coordination. Practicum placements include faith-based organizations, humanitarian initiatives, and large-scale church projects.

Master's Thesis

Students are required to complete a research-based master's thesis exploring faith-based project execution, strategic church operations, or nonprofit development. The thesis should include an applied research component with case studies, leadership models, or ministry-focused implementation plans.

- Lead project teams in corporate, nonprofit, and faith-based settings.
- Apply Christian leadership principles to ministry and project execution.
- Utilize financial, risk, and stakeholder management strategies effectively.
- Integrate faith-based ethics and decision-making into project leadership.
- Develop sustainable and scalable ministry project strategies.
