#### 2. Introduction

## 3. Event Highlights

- Welcome Address and Orientation: The session commenced with a warm welcome to the new members of Cohort 3. Dr. K. Raja Narendar Reddy sir addressed the students with inspiring insights into the importance of creativity, risk-taking, and innovation in building a startup mindset.
- Understanding Entrepreneurship: The speaker discussed the core principles of entrepreneurship, highlighting key traits such as opportunity recognition, value creation, customer focus, innovation, and resilience.
- Introduction to NISP: A detailed explanation of the National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP) was
  provided. Dr. Reddy elaborated on how NISP bridges the gap between academic knowledge and
  entrepreneurial ventures, encouraging students and faculty to engage in innovation-led activities. Key
  focus areas such as IPR, technology transfer, pre-incubation, and funding opportunities were
  discussed.

- Overview of the Startup Ecosystem at KITSW: Participants were introduced to C-i2RE, which acts as a
  central hub for nurturing entrepreneurial talent. The speaker explained how C-i2RE supports ideation,
  mentoring, incubation, and access to funding and market networks.

- Success Stories and Institutional Vision: Dr. K. Raja Narendar Reddy sir also shared inspiring case studies and success stories from alumni entrepreneurs and emphasized KITSW's vision of becoming a leading contributor to India's innovation-driven economy.
