Congratulations! You have made it to your final year of High School

We hope that you are excited as we are as we look toward graduation for the Class of 2026. In order to make sure you get the most out of your senior year (parents and students), we wanted to pass along some important information that you can and should review as soon as possible.

Senior Class first, please make sure that you have joined the google classroom for the class of 2026 – join code is **mjoa25r**. Also join the official Class of 2026 Remind. If you have not, download the blue REMIND app, text **@woodland26** to the number **81010** . If that one is full, text **@WHS2026-2** to the number 81010.

This is how we will notify you of upcoming deadlines and events.

- **Senior Dues:** Senior dues are required for each graduating senior. Senior Dues will be **\$180**. You can pay by cash or money order to Ms. Holiday in the front office or by credit card on MySchoolBucks. Senior Dues can be paid throughout the school year, but students **will not receive their cap and gown** at the end of the year until they are paid. These **dues cover** the following (prices based on 2025 and are subject to change):
 - o Cap/Gown/Tassel/Stoles (\$62)
 - o Diploma and Cover (\$20)
 - o Printing (Graduation Programs and tickets, Senior Celebration programs, etc.) (\$25)
 - o Graduation Extras (Fireworks, etc) – (\$15)
 - o End of Year Senior Activities (\$30)

- **Senior Portraits:** This year portraits will be done through Cady. *See information provided by Cady.* There will be a sitting fee required.
 - o Senior Pictures here at Woodland – 7/25
 - Includes 1-2 Casual, Cap/Gown, & Formal
 - o Senior Pictures In Studio – by appointment
 - Through 11/1 to be included in yearbook
 - Through March for personal
 - **Senior Calendar:** A more extensive calendar will be posted in August
 - o 7/25 - Senior Pictures at Woodland (schedule early for the best times – see attached “how to” directions)
 - **Senior Stuff:** The following are items you may want to budget for (listen for announcements and watch Remind for information and deadlines):
 - o Senior Shirts – \$15 - \$35 (depending on what you order and how many items) Several orders will be made throughout the school year.

- o Prom – \$100 - \$125 depending on when you purchase the tickets. *Don't forget to account for your other prom expenses: food, limos, dresses/tuxes, flowers, etc.*
- o Senior Signs – \$25 - Information will be sent out in April
- o Outstanding Monetary Obligations – cap and gowns will not be issued to any student with outstanding monetary obligation in the system (k-12 grade). Check Infinite Campus.

- **Yearbook items: Senior**

- o Books – purchased online – a link will be added on the school website
- o Price is \$85 (a discount code will be sent out in August to order early at \$65)
- o Senior Recognition Ads – Deadline to purchase a senior ad will be announced in August

- **Graduation Information:**

- o Will be shared in August. More will follow when HCS determines graduation dates later in the year.

Senior Year Credits

Be sure to know your status as a student entering your senior year. Do you have at least 17 credits? Are you on track to meet graduation requirements? Be sure to check your status in the Academic Planner in Infinite Campus prior to the start of summer.

Summer School

If you are not on track for graduation, summer school may be necessary for you to get back on track entering your senior year. After you check Academic Planner, speak with your counselor regarding your options. You may also visit Impact Academy's website for summer school details.

SAT/ACT

If you plan to attend a college/university, the SAT or ACT may be required when you apply. Be sure to check your potential schools to see if standardized test scores are required and make the necessary arrangements to schedule and perform well on the exam.

Class of 2026 Decision Day

We wanted to make sure that the 2026 Decision Day was on your radar. Interested students will need to provide their letters of acceptance, scholarship letters as well as identify the school of your choosing. This means that you want to start working as early as possible preparing for and taking the SAT/ACT or ASVAB (if necessary), applying to colleges, applying for scholarships, applying and interviewing for jobs, registering for the military, etc. so that you are able to participate in this event.

Naviance Required Tasks

Have you completed your junior Naviance tasks? If not, be sure to remain after this meeting and meet with Dr. Williams or a counselor. These tasks must be completed before the end of the school year. When you log into Naviance (Launchpad), and click on "Planner" and then "Tasks," any task that is marked "Required" must be completed.
