

Spring View Middle School Athletic Department

RULES

- **Practice time** – All members of their respective teams must be at all practices designated by the coach. 1st offense will result in a conference with the player, parent and the coach and a one (1) game suspension. 2nd offense will result in removal from the team (these are for unexcused absences). Missing practice (unexcused absences) **will** result in less playing time. **Only coaches and players are allowed to attend practice.**
- **Discipline** – No behavior problems will be tolerated by the coach. 1st offense student/athlete will be sent home. 2nd offense, suspension for one (1) game and 3rd offense will result in removal from the team.
- **Parent Pickup** – Parents must pick up student/athletes within 15 minutes after the end of practice or a game. 1st time parent is late, no problem. 2nd time parent is late will result in a conference between the parent and the coach. 3rd time parent is late will result in Athletic Director involvement.
- **Rule 600** – F.I.S.A.L. bylaws state that a student/athlete may not practice or play for both school and another team/league in the same sport during the school season. (Example: AAU, Church, tournament teams, club, city or any other organized league). **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
Consequences: 1st offense will be removal from the school team and team forfeiture of all past games. **Rule 600 Form enclosed in packet.**
- **Voluntary Athletic Contribution** – VAC is \$55.00 per athlete and is used to cover a variety of costs including; equipment, uniforms, referees and league fees. Parent contribution is vital in keeping our program afloat. The VAC money will be returned if the student/athlete quits or is removed from the team prior to the first away game. **VAC Form enclosed in packet and linked on SV Athletics page on the SVMS website.**
- All athletes must be present for **four periods** during a school day to participate in practices and/or games.
