In addition to the thrilling football action, attendees can look forward to a diverse selection of delicious food options provided by our food truck court and the concession stand.

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all, we kindly request that attendees adhere to the following rules:

- No backpacks
- No open containers

- No outside food or drink
- No pets except for service animals
- No tailgating or bonfires on PSD grounds
- No tolerance of drugs, alcohol, or weapons
- No artificial noisemakers
- No full face paint, full face masks, hand-held signs, whiteboards, sticks, balls, frisbees, anything that discharges powder or smoke, or newspapers
- Shirts and shoes are required

For those eager to secure their seats, both home and visitor fans will have the opportunity to reserve seats ONLY on Friday from 2:30 to 3:00 p.m. Please note that no tape is allowed to save seats.

Furthermore, Peninsula School District Staff is recommended to park in the PSD bus barn, while PHS students are reminded that there is no parking in front of the stadium for Fish Bowl.

In the spirit of giving back to the community, we encourage all attendees to support Food Bowl, which provides donations to our local nonprofit Food Backpacks 4 Kids. This year's Food Bowl competition features GHHS vs. PHS vs. Henderson Bay High School.
