Free Motion #1 and #2 classes must have been completed before taking this class. The Quilting with Rulers class will introduce the Westelee starter set rulers which many of you have purchased and not had the opportunity to learn to use.

Supply List and Picture:

Ruler Foot and 12" arc ruler — the store can help you determine whether you have a high shank or low shank machine which will be important when you purchase the foot. Westelee Sampler Set of rulers specific to your machine, i.e., high shank or low shank Machine in good working order

Sew Steady/extension table if you have one

Gloves if you have them

90 Topstitch needles

Decorative or colored thread to practice with - something that will show up; on your fabric

Suggestion: Polyester thread such as Isacord for quilting in a color that you can see on muslin and several pre-wound bobbins. You can use Aurifil in the bobbins, but not recommended for the top.

Fabric marking pen, pencil or other marking pencil Basic sewing supplies including:
Scissors

Ruler of your choice in order to divide fabric sandwiches into sections (Rulers will also be available in class)

Op. 505 Temporary Adhesive Spray for sandwiches

Three muslin sandwiches measuring approximately 22" x 22" (A sandwich consists of one layer of muslin for top, layer of batting and second layer of muslin for back.) They may be pinned together (safety pins) or sprayed with 505 Spray

PLEASE HAVE SUPPLIES PURCHASED AT LEAST <u>TWO WEEKS</u> PRIOR TO CLASS DATE

YOU MUST KNOW HOW TO OPERATE YOUR MACHINE AND HAVE TAKEN YOUR NEW OWNERS CLASSES IF YOU HAVE A NEW MACHINE. YOU MUST PURCHASE THE "CORRECT SHANK SIZE" WESTELEE SAMPLER SET OF RULERS AND THE RULER FOOT DESIGNED TO FIT YOUR PARTICULAR MACHINE. EXAMPLE: BABYLOCK REQUIRES THE "SURE FOOT" AND DOES NOT DO WELL WITH THE WESTELEE FOOT. YOU WILL ALSO NEED TO PURCHASE THE 12" WESTELEE ARC RULER.
