Membership Report: 3 new members, 12 renewals

Musky Mountain: New property manager, Beth Fines. We are #2 on her list, good conversation with her. Some changes needed to LUA to include agreed upon 2023 trail building goals (see Travis' proposal). Looking to get a 15 year approval, but if we don't, we can pursue a 5 year recreational agreement to allow flexibility as we learn. High confidence that we can start in 2023. Travis Bellman Bid for 5 miles - \$87,648 with \$5000 paid. With 10% down payment get the layout in and line-up subs. [36-48" wide trail with features approximately every 500" on average, including jumps, drops, and technical features.] Accessible trails: anything that is around 32".]
