## **Preschool Tuition Information**

Tuition is waived for students receiving special education services.

\*\* Preschool tuition in Springfield Local Schools is currently \$3000 per year. \*\*
This cost is divided into 10 monthly payments, due August through May of each year.

Families can apply for reduced tuition by completing the <u>Farly Childhood Eligibility Screening</u>
<u>Tool</u> and turning it in at the school district administration building. This form will then be submitted to Lucas County Job and Family Services (JFS).

Lucas County Job and Family Services will then approve or deny the application. Only families who are approved for the Early Childhood Education Grant or Publicly Funded Child Care by JFS are eligible for reduced tuition at Springfield preschool.

In order to qualify for one of these preschool tuition assistance programs families must meet the federal poverty quidelines, which are released by the US Department of Health and Human Services, and are listed below.

Publicly Funded Child Care (PFCC) tuition rates will be determined by Lucas County Job and Family Services.

Early Childhood Education Grant (ECE) tuition rates will be determined with Springfield's sliding preschool tuition scale.

Tuition rates can vary between \$0 and \$300 per month with both of these programs.
