- Good ice time lately
      - Everything is inflated
      - 20% shooting on the season, 40% in the last week, unsustainable oiSH%
      - Murder when Landeskog returns

- Chris Driedger G 10%

- I know it's fun to think about, but Bob is not losing his job
      - Stop
      - It.
      - Stop adding him.

- Jake DeBrusk LW,RW 32%

- Whole reason to grab him was PP1 exposure, which even with Bergeron out he isn't seeing anymore
      - Ice time dipping
      - It's an illusion, he's here to steal your lunch money

- Unsustainably low:

■ Carey Price G 97%

- Canadiens better in front of him than last year
- 2.42 xGA/G, 3.18 GAA
- He is just going through a rough patch. Only way this keeps up is if he's playing through injury or something

■ Matt Dumba D 79%

- Shots are down, that's the biggest problem
- Split PP never helps anyone, but it was expected
- 32% IPP and 8.9% oiSH% are killing him atm.
- Should be a bit better, but a 45 point pace might be the best we can expect

- He lost a %!
- He's actually getting more ice time, more PP %, and more shots lately
- Just unlucky, absolutely nothing to be worried about. The man is elite

- Increasing PP ice time
- Has been a bit lucky, but starting to show closer to a 45-50 point pace rest of season
- Puts up decent peripheral numbers across the board and has been shooting more lately

■ Jakub Vrana LW 61%

- PP1 and increased ice time have inflated his shooting
- , especially given his off nights

- Either one makes an excellent G2 to any starter, and

- Sustainably low:

- Anders Nilsson G 27%

- Party's over
- Way over-indexed at mid-danger saves this season compared to his norm
- Faces too many shots to keep a reliable GAA while also being a risky sv% grab with basically no real W upside. Stream if desperate, but that's probably it

- Brent Burns D 100%

- Still amazing, but maybe not a point per game guy again
- Shots down big time (25%) and offensive zone deployment along with it
- Needs to get shooting again to be where he was last season, a bump in PP % wouldn't hurt either

- Cam Atkinson RW 67%

- Admittedly snakebitten in shooting % (4.8% on the season) and oISH% (6.8%)
- PP ice time is gone, down to 26% over his last 4 games
- Regular ice time is gone. Played 12 and 13 minutes in his last couple of games
- Both can come back, but I think he and Skinner are very similar.
