Please note that we only provide free support if both are up to date and you have not made any changes yourself. If the worst comes to the worst, please also check whether the problem exists in the standard Shopware theme (is understandable), as incompatibilities can also occur as a result of the graphic customization of the shop. These cannot be tested in our tests before publication and are therefore excluded from free support.

As a gesture of goodwill, we will look into your problem if your plugin or shop version is not too old. However, this decision is ours alone as to when we act out of goodwill.

In our case, support means not only fixing errors, but also helping. If something is unclear or incomprehensible, please feel free to write to us.

Tests

You can test all of our plugins for 30 days free of charge and to the full extent. We even ask for it. Only then can you be sure that the plugin is doing exactly what you hoped for or expected. Our support will also support you during this test period under the above conditions.

The plugin

With the plugin start and expiry date you can specify individual activation and deactivation dates for each item. This data can be conveniently maintained in the admin for each article. The activation or deactivation can be done by manually or fully automatically calling the cron job. It is also possible to have an email sent to you listing the products that are about to be deactivated.

Pluginconfiguration (general assignment)

Automatically reactivate items deactivated by the plugin cron job?:

- This configuration is used to e.g. B. to enable a merchandise management system to reactivate a product that has been deactivated by the cron job.

Automatically reactivate manually deactivated articles?:

- If this is activated, articles with a valid start or expiry date are also activated by the plugin cron job if they were previously deactivated manually or created deactivated. If an article is then to remain deactivated, the dates must be emptied.

Adopt main variant to all variants:

- yes - the stored start or expiry date of the main article is applied to all variants
- no - a start and expiry date can be stored for each variant

Send email to shop operator:

- yes - an email is sent (via cronjob), which informs the shop operator about which articles are deactivated.
- no - no information will be sent via email.

Informs about the products that are being (or have been) deactivated.

- yesterday - Lists all products in the email that were deactivated yesterday.
- today - Lists all products in the email that have been deactivated today.
- tomorrow - Lists all products in the email that will be deactivated tomorrow.

- When the product should be activated.

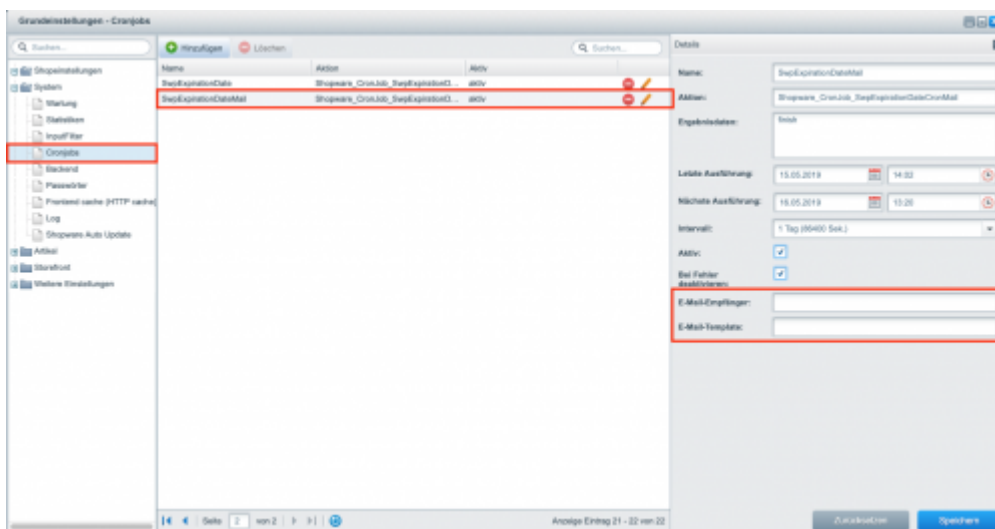
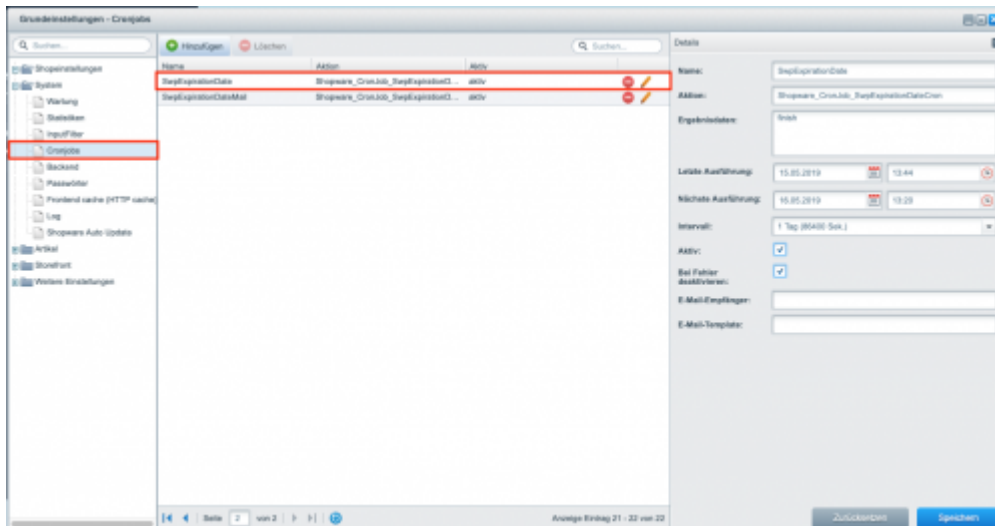


Expiration Date:

- When the product should be deactivated.

cronjobs

required for the plugin in the backend under Basic Settings > System > Cronjobs



Cronjobs SwpExpirationDate

- is responsible for activating or deactivating the product.

SwpExpirationDateMail

- is responsible for sending the notification email. With this cron, an additional email address to which the email is to be sent can also be stored in the email recipient field for each field.
