


## RENEWAL APPLICANTS

Application for students who have received a CPN scholarship in previous years. CEDAR PARK NEIGHBORS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2025-2026 DEADLINE TO APPLY: June 23, 2025, 5 p.m. ET

IMPORTANT NOTE: Applicants must live within the boundaries of Cedar Park in order to apply! Cedar Park is bounded by 46<sup>th</sup> Street, Kingsessing Avenue, the R-3 tracks, 52<sup>nd</sup> Street, and Larchwood Avenue (see map below). Applicants must certify that they live within these boundaries (except when in residence on / near campus). If an application component is not available before the application deadline (such as your Fall 2025 class roster), you must include in its place a statement of when it will be available. Applications without all components included or accounted for by a statement (as described above) will be denied. Applications must be written and submitted solely by the applicant (student). ## **Step-by-Step Application Instructions**

- 1. Check the map above to confirm that you live within the stated boundaries and are eligible to apply. Applicants must live within these boundaries when not at a campus residence during term time. If a student splits time between the residences of two guardians, the student must live within the Cedar Park boundaries over 50% of the time.
- 2. Gather and write all required elements of the application. If an application component is not available before the application deadline (such as your Fall 2025 roster), you must include in its place a statement of when it will be available.
- 3. Put all application components (except your EFC) into a single pdf file in the order of the checklist above. If you do not have access to Adobe Acrobat on a computer, you can find a number of free tools to assist you. Online, you can find free programs (like <a href="https://www.altomerge.com/">https://www.altomerge.com/</a>). If you have a mobile device, you can download free apps (often called pdf scanners) that will enable you to take pictures of a document and turn it into a pdf.
- 4. Double-check that all required documents, or statements explaining when a document will be available, are in the correct order, outlined in the Application Checklist above. **Points will be deducted for components not in order of the checklist above.**
- 5. Name the single pdf with [YourLastName]CPNapp.pdf (for example: SmithCPNapp.pdf)and label your EFC as [YourLastName]CPNEFCapp..pdf
- 6. Send the document via email to <u>scholarships@cedarparkneighbors.org</u> before June 23, 2025, 5 p.m. ET. Applications without all components included or accounted for by a statement (as described above) will be denied. Applications received after June 23, 2025, 5 p.m. ET will also be denied. Applications must be written and submitted solely by the applicant (not a family member or mentor). No hard copies of the application will be accepted.
- 7. You will receive an email confirming receipt of your application. Scholarship winners will be announced by July 14, 2025. There will be an awards ceremony at which you will receive your check, certificate and be celebrated by the community. You and your family are invited and encouraged to attend. Following the ceremony, you and your family are invited and encouraged to join the scholarship committee for a reception. The awards and reception occur in the evening after 6pm. More details will be shared if you are awarded the scholarship. Please plan to attend and have your family join you for both activities
