Mandatory Cadet Orientation

NOMMA Cadet Orientation is mandatory and will begin on August 1, 2023. Please check the [calendar](#) and see below for which day(s) your cadet must attend Cadet Orientation. Arrival time is no later than 7:25 each day. Breakfast will be served from 7:00 - 7:25.

August 1st - 10th Grade (3:05 dismissal)
August 2nd - 12th Grade & 11th Grade (3:05 dismissal)
August 3rd - 8th Grade & 9th Grade (3:05 dismissal)
August 4th - 8th Grade & 9th Grade (12:30 dismissal)

For Cadet Orientation and the first days of school, your cadet will need the following basic school supplies: pens, pencils, and loose-leaf paper or notebook. Cadets may also bring a binder or folder to keep track of class notes. **Per NOMMA Policy, backpacks and bookbags must be mesh or clear, see-through material. Mesh backpacks must be of neutral colors (i.e. black/brown/tan or a combination of the three or olive drab/camouflage). Clear backpacks may only have a black or white lining.**

During Cadet Orientation, all new cadets are expected to wear the NOMMA Civilian Uniform, which consists of khaki pants, a red NOMMA polo, solid black athletic-type shoes, and a belt. Cadets are expected to be in the appropriate grooming standards during Mandatory Cadet Orientation. Uniform and Grooming Guidelines are explained in the "Uniform Guidelines" section of the [Cadet-Parent Handbook](#).

NOMMA Uniforms

The [NOMMA Civilian Uniform](#) consisting of khaki pants and a red polo shirt must be purchased at [Skobel's](#). Skobel's is the only authorized vendor for the civilian uniform. It is required for the cadet's first initial and last name to be embroidered on the shirt, black fleece jacket, and yellow sweatshirt. The civilian uniform shoes must be solid black, including the logo and sole of the shoe. These shoes may be purchased anywhere. Skobel's has all the details and is happy to assist with any questions regarding the civilian uniform.

The Marine Corps JROTC Digital Cammie uniform will be issued to new cadets during the first week of school (Cadet Orientation). Returning cadets must bring in unserviceable and/or ill-fitting uniform items to exchange for new items. Your cadet is required to wear the civilian uniform during Cadet Orientation and will wear the MCJROTC uniform the following week.

School Supplies

General school supply lists will be provided the week of August 7th. Each teacher will provide a list of school supplies needed for their subject throughout the school year. During the first days of school, your cadet will need the following basic school supplies: pens, pencils, loose-leaf paper or a notebook, and a binder or folder to keep track of class notes.

Per NOMMA Policy, backpacks and bookbags must be mesh or clear, see-through material. Mesh backpacks must be of neutral colors (i.e. black/brown/tan or a combination of the three or olive drab/camouflage). Clear backpacks may only have a black or white lining.
