

CHORUS - Harmonious Uniform Option for 2025-26

A uniform identifies the group as a choir at every event in which we perform; therefore, each student must wear the uniform during all performances. Students earn grades for performances and may not perform without the uniform.

Students in Harmonious (1st Period) have the choice of wearing “concert black” or purchasing the upper level choir uniform that will be worn in Bel Canto, Chante, Grandi Voci, Cantoras, and Concert Choir (see previous pages). Students will not be allowed to perform without proper attire (Concert Black or Uniform)

Concert black is defined as:

- completely black Top, covering the shoulders and stomach (no midriff showing)
 - long Dress Pants (no leggings or jeans)
 - black Knee Highs or Socks (all of your legs and feet are covered)
 - black closed-toe Shoes (with a strap or back, no sneakers/tennis shoes)
- OR
- completely black Dress (or Top and Skirt) to mid thigh or longer with
 - black Hosiery (all of your legs and feet are covered)
 - black Shoes (with a strap or back, no sneakers/tennis shoes).

Students will be standing to rehearse and perform for long periods of time; therefore, black flats are recommended.

Grandi Voci Uniform Option 2024-25

It is recommended that students in 4th Period Grandi Voci purchase one of the two

chorus approved uniforms (Tuxedo or dress) but they have the option of wearing “concert black.”

Concert black is defined as:

- A long sleeve black dress shirt
- Black bowtie or knotted tie
- Black coat jacket/blazer optional
- Dress pants (no leggings or jeans)
- Black socks that cover ankles
- Black closed-toe dress shoes

OR

- completely black Dress (or Top and Skirt) to mid thigh or longer with
- black Hosiery (all of your legs and feet are covered)
- black dress Shoes (with a strap or back).

2024-2025 CHORUS Fair Share and Fundraisers

Money collected from Fair Share and Fundraisers is used to provide a unified T-shirt for all chorus students, purchase music (including downloadable copies) and part tracks, pay registration fees for the Choral Music Performance Assessment, All-State, ACDA, and All County, pay for buses, piano accompanist, musicians, clinicians, defray cost to students, printer paper, printer ink, and much more. Our most pressing capital need is the replacement of the risers we use on the stage, which were purchased over 19 years ago. With prior fundraisers, we have purchased 8 and need 2 more risers.

Fair Share - The Fair Share is **\$25 due Wednesday, September 10th**(Includes a Chorus T-shirt in addition to the needs above).

Fundraiser – August 20th presentation – *Snap!Raise* will be our platform this year. We are asking students to collect 20 email addresses of people who would support their singing such as extended family members, adult friends of the family, community leaders they may know like coaches, piano/voice teacher, religious groups, parents' work colleagues, etc. An email will be sent to these friends to help us raise funds for our choir needs this year (see above for how these funds are utilized). This is also a good way to raise funds for the Fair Share, Uniforms, for individuals participating in All-State, Solo & Ensemble, and other trips.
