M1: students may become exposed to psychological problems

S1: peer pressure, depression, atychiphobia syndrome

S2: Be fearful, unmotivated and disconnected

M2: Become intolerant and iron-hearted

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When it comes to a benefit associated with the tendency, it is believed that the schools' encouragement makes pupils keep practicing and cultivating themselves everyday. Since learning is a never-ending process, especially in this era, it is required that individuals need to be adaptable and knowledgeable to acclimatize to society, and get prepared for any challenges. If schoolchildren hesitate to have self-development, it is inevitable that they might be left behind in the future regarding skills, knowledge and experience when their colleagues or peers are more skillful and well-performed. The University Entrance Exam in Vietnam is considered a typical example, which is reasonably competitive and stressful. As for students, each 0.25 point is a chance that if they are not well-prepared for this big day, they are unlikely to be admitted to their favorable universities. However, I believe the aforementioned positives are eclipsed by some enormous downsides, the most significant one is that students may become exposed to psychological problems. When there are various expectations from schools, parents and relatives appear, motivations then become pressures. Pupils possibly feel peer pressure, depression and even atychiphobia syndrome which causes them to be fearful, unmotivated and disconnected. As a result, they are reluctant to compete, socialize and even cooperate with others, wondering “What if I fail?” whenever the chance comes. Moreover, if students are educated repressively with conventional and inefficient methods, they are likely to be intolerant and iron-hearted individuals. Since the concept of being competitive and self-reliant has been in their blood, they will desire to achieve anything they want regardless of cunning or cruel behavior. In 2022, a 16-year-old student in Hanoi, Vietnam suicided because of the pressure from his mother’s expectations. ‘I was, am and will never be enough for you, mom’ he wrote in his suicide note. Unfortunately, there are still many cases of the same thing in this world; hence, educating students to be someone who never feels enough may cause many consequences.
