Sign up here for emergency alerts. You can sign up for an alert at your own location, as well as the location of your buddy.

Everyone in Alameda County should know what zone they are located in. Officials will use zones in their emergency alerts.

For example, an alert might say something like this: *These zones must EVACUATE NOW: BER-E025, BER-E026, BER-E036*
