Quotation is the direct copy paste of sentences; summary is to make the original passage shorter by choosing only the main ideas/controlling ideas.</p> <p>4.When we want to preserve the original information using a different form to avoid plagiarism.</p>

Group 5	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1.Paraphrasing is rewriting a passage or text using different words without changing the meaning.2. The purpose of paraphrasing is to avoid plagiarism.3. Quotation is taking the passage or text word by word directly without changing anything and summarizing is restatement of the main ideas of the passage or text.4. We paraphrase when we get information from a source and we want to avoid plagiarizing the source.
