- June 2025

May 1, 2026

Deadline to submit Student Intent to Register (SIR) to CSU campus of choice

July 2026

University admission applications provide applicants an opportunity to report degrees and certificates conferred. You will need to know the type of degree, major, and award date (anticipated future award date is ok). See your counselor for assistance.

How to Report Select Fall 2025 Coursework

While our system updates to reflect Common Course Numbering (CCN), please report your Fall 2025 Chabot & LPC courses in your Transfer Planners and Applications in the **bolded CCN** format.

For example: if you are enrolled in Fall 2025 POSC C1, then in your Transfer Planners/Applications, search for *POLS C1000* to add to your Academic History. If you cannot search to add it, type it in manually in the CCN format.
