Open letter to the American Geophysical Union on its Presidential Citation for Senator Cory Gardner

As signatories to this letter and members of the American Geophysical Union, we write to express our objections to the award of an AGU Presidential Citation to Senator Cory Gardner. The award exists to "recognize leaders whose work has helped advance Earth and space science and increase the understanding and appreciation of its value to society". A <u>recent AGU communication</u> justifies Senator Gardner's award as rooted in his "bipartisan efforts to pass the American Innovation and Competitiveness Act of 2017".

While we are grateful for continued federal support of geoscience research, Senator Gardner's public positions on many aspects of the Earth and environmental sciences reflect his rejection of scientific findings uncovered by decades of research by AGU scientists. Indeed, <u>Senator Gardner voted in 2015 against recognizing human-induced climate change</u>, in direct contradiction of the AGU's position statement entitled "<u>Human-induced climate change requires urgent action</u>". Furthermore, Senator Gardner's tenure in the Senate is marked by <u>opposition to science-based legislation to protect the environment</u>. Americans deserve leaders who recognize the value of science as a critical ingredient to our nation's health and prosperity, and there are many such leaders - Republicans and Democrats alike - who deserve the honor of an AGU Presidential Citation. Senator Gardner is not one of them.

In rewarding Senator Gardner with this high honor, the AGU is sending a dangerous message -that policymakers are free to pick and choose scientific facts that serve their political agendas,
and disregard those that do not. With the recent release of the <u>Fourth National Climate</u>
<u>Assessment</u>, it is clearer than ever that climate change represents a growing threat to the health
and well-being of all Americans. The Assessment underscores that urgent action is needed to
protect vulnerable communities from climate change impacts.

As AGU scientists, we are committed to advancing science in the public good, and would welcome any opportunity to engage with Senator Gardner and other policymakers to address issues of critical national importance, including climate change.
