- Once nominated, nominees will be responsible for completing an online application which will be emailed to them if they wish to be considered for selection

## Who can nominate?

 Nominations can be made by a program director, assistant program director, department chair, or existing AOA member. You can only nominate one candidate per calendar year.

## How and what do I submit?

- Demographic Information (include in email body):
  - Your name, contact information (phone and email), and role (PD, APD,
    Department Chair, or existing AOA member)
  - Nominee's name, reliable contact information (phone and email), applicant category (resident, fellow, faculty, or alumnus), and clinical specialty
  - Missing information may result in delays or exclusion of your nominee from the election process
- Blinded letter of nomination (attach as PDF): Submit an attached nomination letter (Recommended length of 1 page) in PDF format stating reasons for recommending the candidate. We recommend writing your letter based on these five areas: scholarship (i.e. academic achievement/research), leadership, service, professionalism, and teaching/mentoring). To keep the letter blind, use general phrases such as "this fellow, resident, Captain X" etc
