UPDATED April 2, 2025

The results from April 1's Illinois Consolidated Election are in, and most of the outcomes are pretty promising when it comes to elections for public library board trustee. I've gone through the entire list of contested elections below. A couple of helpful notes:

- Winning candidates are highlighted in magenta and their names are bold
- If the winner was one of concern, beside their names and concerns you'll see *Winner in magenta.
- A couple of the elections are either too close to call or, in one case, a complete tie. I
 noted these edge cases.

The Illinois Library Lovers Guide to Public Library Elections

April 1, 2025 is the date of the next Consolidated election in Illinois. Many public library boards have elections this year, meaning that the future of your library may be on the ballot. This guide is intended to help voters navigate these elections in contested races. If your race is not contested, meaning that there are only as many candidates as there are spots available (or fewer), then your library race will not be on here.

The contests included in the guide here are those where there are more candidates than there are positions and it is intended to help narrow down who may be best suited to represent your library over the next 2, 4, or 6 years. You may see some contested seats for unexpired terms. This means that the length of service will be shorter than standard length, and the length of that term is noted.

Candidates here may be color coded Green means they'd be a great candidate. Yellow means little information is available about them and their positions or that they would pose no threat to the library if elected but they are not as strong of candidates as those in green. Finally, red is an indication not to vote for the candidate. Where information as to why is available, such as links to platforms or affiliations, those are included. *Most candidates are not given a color*, as tracking down all of that information proved impossible. But the information provided here should be a significant help in making pro-library decisions, whether it's through published candidate profiles or candidate forums (either recorded or forthcoming in person).

This guide was created by library workers and library advocates in the state of Illinois. Questions, comments, or insight into any races without much information <u>can be dropped into this handy form</u>.
