Introduction to Paper Piecing

Foundation paper piecing is a popular technique in making quilts but can seem incredibly intimidating if you haven't tried it. It's done by sewing fabric to a printed paper foundation. This method is beloved by quilters because it can be used to create extremely precise points and shapes. Join Summer in the classroom and learn the basics!

Project Supplies needed:

- Add a Quarter ruler in either the 6" or 12" size
- Cutting mat and rotary cutter
- Flat head pins

Preparing for class:

Pre cut fabric as per the following:

- **Tree Block:**
 - Cut one 2 x 1.5" trunk
 - Cut two 2 x 3 background
 - Cut two 5 x 3 background
 - Cut one 5 x 4 tree
- **Star Block:**
 - **Background:**
 - Cut eight 3 x 3 squares
 - **Star Points:**
 - Cut eight 4 x 2 rectangles
 - **Center Square:**
 - Cut one 3 x 3 square
- **Log Cabin Block** - note: *instead of cutting each block bring a few strips of 2" wide fabric*
