

Faithful Servant Award – Veteran Nomination Criteria

This award honors a veteran who has demonstrated unwavering dedication, exceptional service, and a lifelong commitment to uplifting others through leadership, integrity, and selfless acts.

Eligibility:

- Must be a U.S. military veteran (honorably discharged or currently serving in reserve/guard status).
 - Demonstrated consistent involvement in community service or veteran advocacy.
 - Embodies the values of honor, duty, and service beyond their military career.
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Nomination Criteria

Nominations will be evaluated based on the following areas:

1. Military Service & Sacrifice (20 points)

- Distinguished military service with honor and integrity.
- Acts of courage, leadership, or significant contributions during service.
- Dedication to supporting fellow service members and veterans.

2. Community Impact (30 points)

- Demonstrated commitment to improving their local community through volunteerism or advocacy.
- Active participation in programs that support veterans, families, or underserved populations.
- Evidence of creating sustainable, positive change.

3. Leadership & Integrity (20 points)

- Serves as a role model through strong character and ethical leadership.
- Inspires others to serve and give back.
- Demonstrates humility and selflessness in service to others.

4. Faithful Service Beyond the Uniform (20 points)

- Continuation of servant leadership after military career.

- Commitment to living a life guided by purpose, compassion, and service.

5. Enduring Legacy (10 points)

- Long-term contributions that have left a lasting impact on the veteran community and beyond.
- Recognition of lifetime achievements that align with the values of the award.

Supporting Documentation

Nominations should include:

- A completed nomination form.
- A narrative (500-750 words) detailing the nominee's qualifications.
- Up to three letters of support from individuals or organizations.
- Optional: photos, awards, or news articles highlighting the nominee's service.
