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Note: It is important to pick **TWO ALTERNATE COURSES**. It is important that you pick these courses carefully. If you have a conflict or a course is over capacity, you will be put into one of your Alternate Courses. If you don't pick alternates at the time of course selection, courses can reach capacity, and you could have limited selection of other courses. Not picking alternate courses does not guarantee that you will get into all your choices. There could be timetable conflicts or too many people have selected a course.

M level courses are recognized by both Colleges and Universities.

It is important to look at the **courses that alternate years**. Some courses will be offered during your Gr 11 school year but not when you are in Gr 12. If you are interested in taking one of these courses, it's important to select it for the 2023-2024 school year.

If you are interested in taking an E-learning course, pick 8 courses at North Middlesex. Once you get accepted into your E-learning course, we will remove one of the courses in your timetable.

If you are planning on taking an E-learning course in the SUMMER, you must still pick that course in your timetable. For example, you want to take Gr 11 English online in July, you must

still pick Gr 11 English in your timetable. Once you have received your summer school credit, we will remove that course from your timetable.

Summer school courses will be available in **May 2023**. When these courses are available, if you are interested in taking a summer e-learning course, please make a guidance appointment to discuss available courses and registration.
