The King Baseball Instructional Camp (**KBIC**) was founded in 1983. The goal of the camp is to improve the physical and mental skills of young baseball players. **INSTRUCTION** is at the heart of the camp. This is accomplished through state-of-the-art drills and superior training devices. All facets of the game will be covered: conditioning, throwing, fielding, bunting, hitting, base running, base stealing, sliding and strategy. Motivation and Fun dominate the KBIC days. All campers will play in an All-Star Showcase Series on the final day of camp. Players should bring a cap, glove, bat, sweats or baseball pants, spikes and sneakers, **towel**, (no muscle shirts), lunch and a jug of water/juice (no soda). All campers will receive a KBIC T-shirt.

Camp Director: COACH LOU LOMBARDO – Founder of KBIC; GM-Fort Washington Golden Generals and former Head Coach at Ft W and Montgomery CC. His teams have 1,300+ victories and 39 championships. Eighteen of his players have played professional baseball, four advanced to the major leagues. Lou is a member of the Pennsylvania ALB Hall of Fame and the Pennsylvania MC Chapter Coaches Hall of Fame. Lombardo is a member of the American Baseball Coaches Association and director of the Mid Atlantic Collegiate Baseball Scouting Alliance. He is the bench coach for the Wissahickon Packers (Perkiomen Collegiate Semi Pro League). Professional players attend his off-season workout sessions; 200+ KBIC campers have advanced to college baseball.
