    - o Cons: There is a lot of garbage, rules around carnivals, don't make that much money
  - Is there a better way to raise money?
  - The PTA did not want to do a combined fundraiser and split funds.
  - Ideas: Coupon books, art auction, dunking booth, Mario Kart competition or tournament
  - Idea to hold a fundraiser on the night of the STEAM Spring Showcase.
  - Ms. Ewell and Mr. Davenport will look at the policy
  - Rich Wills will look for ideas and develop options for our next meeting.
