2026 Fete and Trivia Night Sponsorship Pack

About Us

Weetangera Primary School was established in 1973. Today our school has almost 500 students attending from Preschool to Year 6, and is used as a community centre for a range of outside of school activities from weekend hockey and soccer to calisthenics clubs.

The Weetangera Primary P&C organises a range of events for students, parents and members of the local community with two goals in mind. The first of these is to raise funds for upgrades to school amenities. The second is to build a sense of community for students and their families.

In 2026 the Weetangera Primary P&C is excited to bring back two major fundraising events:

- The biennial Weetangera fete, to be held on Sunday 15 November at the school, will feature traditional cake, book and toy stalls as well as a range of fun activities for our students and the wider community.
- The annual Weetangera P&C trivia night, to be held in August 2026, gives our parent body the chance to come together away from the classrooms.

Both of these events will enable us to raise funds for our school and to bring together both our school community and wider Weetangera community.

What will the money raised be used for?

In recent years our primary focus has been on improving outdoor learning and play spaces, particularly those used by children during recess and lunch breaks. We will continue to fundraise toward this in 2026, while also offering funding for other opportunities identified by the school executive to most effectively improve the schooling experience of Weetangera students and staff.

Over the last 4 years the P&C been proud to support the school through:

- More than \$60,000 raised over three years to fund a new climbing structure-based playground to be built in early 2026;
- A 50% contribution to the construction of a nature playground in 2024;
- Funding for improvements to our school's community garden;
- Annual \$1,000 contribution towards Year 6 yearbooks and graduation activities; and

- Nearly \$7,000 towards the purchase of sports and play equipment that students can use during recess and lunch breaks.

What can you donate?

For the trivia night, we are primarily seeking 'in-kind' donations that could be used as raffle prizes and silent auction items. Donations can be gifts or goods that suit the adults attending or their children, food items, gift vouchers for goods or services, tickets to events, and so on. These items will be showcased at the trivia night.

For the fete, we are able to accept donations of items for raffle prizes, as well as cash donations to help fund the costs associated with the event and ensure more of the money raised on the day goes straight back to our school community. We are also happy to explore other ways that you may be able to support the event, including services or activities that support promotion of the event, or donation or loan of items that could be used on the day.

How will my business be recognised?

We will of course be happy to appropriately recognise the businesses that support our trivia night with donations of any kind. The attached tables show the types of recognition that will be provided based on the value of your contribution for each of the fete and/or trivia night. As recognition of a substantial contribution to our school fundraising activities, Platinum, Gold and Silver sponsors who have signed on before 31 July 2026 will receive the benefits of both the trivia night and fete.
