Grade K

Materials Needed:

8.5 x 11 tagboard (1 per student)

Pencils (1 per student)

Oil Pastels, Crayons or Markers

Presentation: Present Slideshow

Demo: Demonstrate how to draw a basic mushroom shape on a piece of tagboard. Explain that the mushroom will then be filled in with dots. Each child should draw at least 2 mushrooms on their paper and they are welcome to do more. The background should also be filled in with dots. The dots can be of varying sizes and shapes.

Lesson: Excuse the children back to their seats to work on their mushroom projects. Have them draw the mushrooms first with pencil and then color with the medium of your choice.

Wrap Up: If time allows, meet together to present completed projects. Then have the children help with the clean up.
