Above & Beyond (4.0)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can find books that could help me answer a question (for example, if I have a pile of books, I can look at their titles and pictures to find out which ones would tell me about fish that live in the ocean).
3.5	I can do all of the things at level 3.0, and I can do some of the things at level 4.0.
Proficient (3.0)	SR1—I can use a book my teacher gives me to find an answer to a question (for example, I can answer the question <i>What happens when a starfish loses a ray?</i> by reading or listening to <i>Starfish</i> by Edith Thacher Hurd).
2.5	I can do all of the things at level 2.0, and I can do some of the things at level 3.0.
Getting There (2.0)	SR1— I know what certain words mean (for example, <i>answer, event, illustration, person, place, question, thing, word</i>) and can do things such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tell the person, place, event, or thing a question is asking about. Point out pictures that show something a question is asking about. Point out words in a book that match important words in a question. Tell if an answer to a question makes sense (for example, when someone asks <i>What are your favorite pizza toppings?</i>, I know that the answer should be different kinds of foods that can be put on a pizza).
1.5	I can do some of the things at level 2.0 and at level 3.0.
Beginning (1.0)	I can do some of the things at level 2.0 and at level 3.0 with help.
