#### Key Features of the App:

- Use the live video camera, or import pre recorded videos, photos, and artwork
- Combine up to 3 image sources at a time
- Scrollable timeline makes it easy to sequence your videos and photos
- Move, scale, rotate and crop your image sources (photos, videos)



- Mask out unwanted areas in your image sources (photos, videos, live camera)
- Create green screen photos and save to camera roll
- Scrollable timeline makes it easy to sequence your videos and photos
- Trim videos on the timeline to keep only the parts you need
- Save your recorded videos to your camera roll (and from there to YouTube, email, etc.)
- Create and save multiple projects
