- 1. What is Title I:** The Title I, Part A program provides financial assistance each year to Local Education Agencies (LEAs) and schools to help ensure that all students have equitable opportunities to meet challenging state academic standards. Funds are used to provide supplemental educational services and resources to meet the needs of economically and educationally disadvantaged students.
- 2. Our school's Title I allocation & How will Title I funds be spent:** Our allocation goes toward mentor salaries who give additional and supplemental instructional help for students. Terra Academy Community Counsel has determined that early childhood literacy is the focus of Title I funding.
- 3. The following criteria are used to identify students for services:**
 - a. Free and reduced lunch qualifiers
 - b. Below benchmark scores on assessments
 - c. Below expected growth on benchmark assessments
- 4. Title I students (instructional programs):** Utilizing Lexia Reading, Wilson Reading, Wonders Curriculum, Mastery Connect, and other programs to individualize education for each student.
