HOW TO USE THIS BOOKLET

1. Read all important information in the beginning of this booklet and contact mse@miltonps.org with any questions.
2. Look at the AT A GLANCE section, under the grade your child will enter in Fall 2026 to view course offerings for each hour.
3. Read the descriptions of the courses listed in the booklet to make decisions about courses your child(ren) might be interested in.
4. Register online using the [FamilyID website](#) beginning on **February 25th at noon**. Keep in mind that this MSE Brochure is sent out early just for planning purposes, and course offerings and times are subject to change before registration opens.

REGISTRATION

All registration will take place online. There will be no mail-in registration.

***Important change to note: Students must be registered for either two hours of courses or four hours. In order to ensure safety and security during the pick up and drop off transitions, we will have staff available to greet students at 8:00 am and 10:00 am as well as to dismiss students at 10:00 am and 12:00 pm.**

Live course registration will begin on **February 25th** via FamilyID. [Click here to register your child.](#)

When registering, make sure that you register each of your children separately - signing each child up for a maximum of four courses. If you select more than four courses for any given child, you will forfeit their spot in those courses and have to re-register!

Payment:

- After selecting all courses, enter the total dollar amount for the cost of your courses.
- You will be given the option to select 'Pay by My School Bucks'
- My School Bucks is the same system for our food services -- if you do not have an account on My School Bucks, please create an account prior to expedite your checking out.
- ***You must present your confirmation to pick up and receive your child(ren)'s lanyard and to participate in MSE. If you cannot provide your proof of payment, your registration will be forfeited.***

Courses are filled on a first come, first serve basis. As courses fill, they will be removed from the drop down menus and will no longer be available to register, even though they are still listed in



this brochure. Registration issues or questions should be directed to MSE Directors Ellen Lohan and Caroline Morton (mse@miltonps.org).

If your child requires medication that will be held by the nurse at MSE, you must meet the nurse and drop off medications by July 6th.

PRE - K PROGRAM

Pre-K students attend all four hours each day. Children who participate must be four years old by September 1, 2026 (no exceptions) and NOT entering Kindergarten in September. MSE Pre-K students must be fully toilet-trained.

Over the course of the four hours, Pre-K students engage in developmentally appropriate play and learning experiences, including (but not limited to) read-alouds, exploratory centers, arts and crafts, outdoor play and exploration, basic letter/number exposure, social skill development through games, and more!

Due to space restrictions, the number of spaces in the Pre-K class is limited. The cost of the Pre-K Program is \$1,000

DROP OFF/ PICK UP

In the interest of safety and having a smooth and swift process, it is crucial that all parents understand and follow these directions when dropping off and picking up at this location:

Drop off students at the front of MSE entrance. The entrance is located at the bottom of Gile Road in the lower parking lot. Please have your child ready to exit your vehicle from the right side. Our “red shirt” staff will be ready to receive students and escort them inside to their first period teacher.

If you feel it necessary to bring your child into the building yourself, for safety's sake, you **MUST** park in the lower parking lot against the guide rails and must walk down towards the end door and use the walkway. Do not try to walk through the parking lot.

Pick up will be divided alphabetically and is subject to change: (*this is the same process as the last three years*)

Last names beginning A-L should be picked up at the main entrance of Milton High School, on Gile Road. You **MUST** enter and exit through the Canton Avenue driveway and follow the guidance of staff stationed at the entrance at Canton Avenue.

Last names beginning M-Z should be picked up at the main entrance of MSE (in the lower parking lot off of Gile Road) and you **MUST** enter and exit through the Blue Hill Parkway



driveway.

The arrival and dismissal processes help to create a safe and efficient environment for all MSE families. All families will be provided a map outlining the new dismissal plan prior to the start of MSE, when you pick up your child's schedule and registration packet on one of the aforementioned dates.

In both Pick Up locations, please stay in your car; your child will be escorted to you.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Minimum Enrollment:** Classes with fewer than ten students may be canceled at the director's discretion.
- **Transportation:** Milton Summer Enrichment does not provide transportation. Parents/guardians are responsible for picking up their children promptly at the end of their class. A late pick-up fee of \$5.00 per five minutes late will be charged.
- **Groupings:** Students are grouped according to the grade entering in Fall of 2026.
- **Refunds:** Refunds will be granted only if a class is canceled.
- **Attendance Policy:** Students should let teachers know in advance if an absence is expected. MSE does NOT contact parents when a student is absent.

Behavioral Expectations:

Milton Summer Enrichment (MSE) encourages positive behavior that allows for a safe environment for all students. Participation in the program is subject to students demonstrating good behavior, and is a privilege, not a right, that can be taken away if not in good standing at the discretion of the MSE Directors.

Behavioral Expectations include:

- Listen and follow staff expectations
- Show respect to adults and other students
- Show respect for school property and the property of others
- Avoid disruptive behavior including loud talking, yelling and throwing objects
- Inappropriate touching including but not limited to hitting, biting or fighting
- Exhibit good sportsmanship
- Use appropriate and respectful language
- Remain with staff at all times unless given permission otherwise
- Do not verbally or physically bully others

If a student does not meet the program's expectations and/or has difficulty controlling their behavior in accordance with this policy, MSE may require the student to sit out from activities, be redirected to another activity, suspended temporarily from the program or permanently removed from the program. A child may be immediately dismissed from the program if the child's behavior is determined to be detrimental to the child or the well-being of others.

2026 COURSE OFFERINGS

All The World's A Stage: Do you have a budding performer wanting to learn more about acting? Join someone who studied acting and worked in NYC to learn about everything that goes into putting on a play. We'll read children's books and turn them into plays and perform them.

Animal Crafts: We will go through each letter of the alphabet and learn about a new animal each day. Then we will make a craft specific to the letter or animal of the day! Lots of crafting and hands-on fun!

Bracelet Club: Join Ms. Lloyd this summer for a colorful journey of creativity and friendship! In the Bracelet Club, you will learn the art of knotting and crafting beautiful, personalized bracelets while also making new friends! Whether you are a beginner or bracelet-making pro, this is a fun place to express yourself, share stories, and create long-lasting bonds. Let's tie our friendships together in the most fun and creative way!

Chapter Book Club: Come read with us! We will be choosing from a variety of chapter books like The Magic Treehouse, I Survived, The 39 Clues, and more! Each day will focus on a new chapter/section of a book, with special activities to match the text.

Characters and Creatures: Create crazy creatures, build their own world, write silly stories about them! We will bring our imagination to life through hands-on projects, while also using storytelling and creative writing skills. If you can imagine it, you can do it!

Coding & Robotics with Kibo Robots & Scratch Jr.: Let's learn to code! Campers will learn how to code and create a program using blocks to code a Kibo robot to move in different ways, record and make a sound, flash lights, and more! We will build with Legos and other materials to solve different STEM challenges as we code with Kibo. We will also learn how to code using Scratch Jr, an app for Chromebooks & iPads. Campers will learn the importance of the order of events and sequencing with both Scratch Jr and Kibo.

Computer Games: Join us this summer with our Computer game class. This dynamic class introduces students to the exciting world of computer gaming. Students will learn to play many different games as well as learn and practice basic coding skills.

Crafts A to Z: Your child will do arts and crafts that correlate with the letters of the alphabet! Each day, we will do a different craft based on a specific letter! Starting on the first day with the letter A, while working through the alphabet over the summer. For example: Letter E: create a paper plate Elephant Head, Letter I: Build a triple-decker scoop of Ice Cream Cone and Letter



O: watch out for the stringy-legged Octopus. Your child will bring home lots of amazing creations. Let's have a CRAFTY SUMMER!

Creative Coding with Scratch: Let's code using Scratch! Campers will learn how to code using block coding called Blockly to create games and projects. All levels of experience are welcome as campers create their own games. Projects will include learning how to move sprites or characters on the screen, making sounds and music, animation, and more! All projects will be interactive for others to play!

Creative Projects with Google Apps: Let's get creative while using Google Apps! Campers will learn how to create the following projects with Google Apps: Stop Motion Animation, Choose Your Own Adventure, Games and Game Shows, and Pixel Art. We will use Google Slides, Sheets, and Drawings to learn a variety of skills. Campers will create their own pictures from shapes in Google Drawings, design, animate and create games in Google Slides, and create art and games in Google Sheets.

Delicious Art Adventures: Are you interested in making artwork that looks good enough to eat? Do you enjoy working with your hands, using your imagination, and getting a little messy? In this class, students will create fun and exciting art projects with a food theme. Students will design artworks that range from donut sculptures to sushi rolls using a variety of materials such as paper mache, watercolor, mixed media collage, and more to create some delicious treats!

Disney Dance + Crafts: Learn some dance moves and create your own dances to various Disney songs! We will learn pre-choreographed dances to songs from movies like Moana, Descendants, Sing, and so many more. Everyone will also get a chance to make up their own dances and show off their awesome dance moves. No dance experience necessary, this is for having fun, being silly, and dancing your heart out! In between all the dancing, we will do some coloring and other fun crafts!

Dive Into Creativity: Under the Sea Art Adventure! (grades 3-5). Ready to swap your sneakers for flip flops, sand, and a paintbrush? Come take the plunge into the deep blue ocean for an immersive art experience. In this class, students will create oceanscapes inspired by the New England coastline, 3-D jellyfish from upcycled materials, guided paintings focusing on colorful coral reefs, and the animal life that thrives in the depths of the ocean. Whether you're a budding Picasso or just love to get messy, this class is designed to help you make a splash!

Engineering is for Everyone: What better tool to help us build than LEGOs? Science and engineering will collide in this problem-solving class, where we will use LEGOs to help us create solutions to problems. Maybe there is a dangerous river that people need to cross, but there is no bridge. Or maybe there is an animal that needs a new home. No fear, young engineers to the rescue! In this course, we will explore science through building and hands-on problem solving, while learning about the engineering design process and the importance of teamwork and redesign.

Flag Football Phenoms: Get ready to huddle up and head for the end zone! Flag Football Phenoms is the perfect place for students to dive into the fundamentals of flag football. No matter who you are, Flag Football is your chance to run, throw, jump, and fly. This is your chance to get involved in the action and join the flag football movement.

French is Fun I: The summer program "French Is Fun" is designed for 2nd and 3rd-grade

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French Immersion students who want to keep practicing and strengthening their French skills during the summer. This program allows students to use French in a relaxed and enjoyable environment. Through fun activities such as interactive online activities, role-playing, games, songs, and movies, learners stay engaged while building confidence. Game On! Board Game Club: Let the games begin! In our Board Game Class, kids will explore classic and modern games while learning teamwork, strategy, and good sportsmanship. This engaging, screen-free experience encourages critical thinking, taking turns, and social skills, all while having tons of fun with friends.

Greek Mythology: Follow along the journeys of Hercules, Perseus, Theseus, Jason and the Argonauts, and more. There will also be analysis of different creatures and monsters such as the phoenix, Cerberus, Medusa, Pegasus, and more. This course will explore the Greek Gods and discuss their roles in mythological stories.

K Pop Demon Hunters Dance + Trivia: Do you love K-Pop Demon Hunters? Learn some dance moves and create your own dances to various K-Pop songs! We will learn pre-choreographed dances and make up a few of our own. We will also test our knowledge of K-Pop Demon Hunters with some trivia and other fun activities to learn everything there is to know. No dance experience necessary, this is for anyone who loves all things K-Pop Demon Hunters and wants to have fun and be silly!

Kids Yoga Fun with Freckle Face Yoga: This class blends movement, imagination, and play. Through yoga poses, games, and stories, kids will work to build strength, balance, and confidence. We'll also incorporate self-regulation skills with age-appropriate breathing exercises, meditation, and mindful crafts. No yoga experience needed — just a willingness to move and have fun

Let's Start French!: The summer program “Let’s Start French” is designed especially for beginners in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade who are not enrolled in the French Immersion program but would love to learn the basics of French. During the program, students will learn basic greetings, simple sentences, and everyday vocabulary. Lessons are taught through interactive games, songs, and creative activities that make learning enjoyable and stress-free. This playful approach helps learners build confidence while practicing speaking and listening skills. By the end of the program, participants will have a strong and exciting first experience with French.

Little Stitches Sewing: Students will learn the basics of sewing, including how to thread needles, cut patterns, basic stitching, and design. Students will make purses, keychains, pillows, stuffed animals, potholders, cell phone cases, gift bags and much more! Students will have a 'Make-up and Catch-up Day' to finish any incomplete projects. They will also have a 'create your



own project' day where students can create their own projects and explore their creativity.

Milton's Got Talent: Do you love to sing, dance, and do online music trends to your favorite artists' music? Come show off your talents this summer and join Milton's Got Talent! Each week, we'll put down our phones and tablets and learn about music and movement through popular songs and dances.

More Sports Plus: Come play all your favorite gym games, like Matball, Doctors & Soldiers, Wiffleball, Capture the Flag, and more. Learn how to work with others and make new friends while getting some fun exercise!

No-Bake Kitchen Creations: This non-bake cooking class is specially designed for students who enjoy learning through hands-on activities. Students will explore simple, safe, and delicious recipes such as desserts, appetizers, and snacks that require no baking. The class encourages creativity, teamwork, and following instructions in a fun and supportive environment. With a strong focus on safety and easy-to-make recipes, students will gain confidence in the kitchen. Enrollment is limited to 15 students to ensure personalized attention and an engaging experience for everyone.

Passport to Creativity: Art Across the Seven Continents: Ready to turn your summer into a global expedition? Grab your "passport" and pack your imagination! In this class, students won't just learn about art—they'll travel the globe to create it. Each project, we "land" on a new continent to explore its unique pulse, colors, and traditions. From the intricate patterns of Australian Aboriginal dot painting to the vibrant textiles of South America, students will build a diverse portfolio of masterpieces using a wide variety of art mediums.

Problem Solving Challenges: Can you build the tallest tower? Can you make the longest maze? Using recycled materials, students will work together to solve hands-on engineering challenges. Each day will be a different and exciting adventure! See how you can put your creativity and logic to the test!

Puzzle Masters: Join the world of puzzle solving! Each day we will work through a variety of puzzles - word searches, crosswords, sudoku, Wordle, jigsaw puzzles, and more. We will also discuss strategies in order to solve a variety of puzzles.

Random Challenges: This class is for the kid who wants to do it all! Gym games, egg drops, relay races, board games, everything "random." Every day we'll have a new challenge to exercise our bodies and minds and win some prizes. You don't want to miss the chance to win some random challenges!

Read and Create: Join our Read & Create Club this summer! Each session, we'll enjoy a story together and then make a fun craft inspired by the book. It's a relaxed, creative space for kids to explore stories, use their imagination, and create hands-on art.

Run Club and Fun!: This summer enrichment course is for all kids who want to get up and move! Through running and playing games, we will learn how to work together and find movement that is fun and exciting for everyone! We will explore different kinds of movement each week, like running, walking, dance, yoga, team-building games, and more!

Step-by-Step Learning to Draw for Beginners: Calling all artists! Join our easy to follow step by step drawing class to help build drawing skills. Students will create and color a work of art daily.

Summertime Bracelet Club: Let's kick off a summer of making new friends and creating your own wonderful, unique bracelets! It's more than just a craft—it's a chance to vibe with new friends, share designs, and create heartfelt gifts for your family and friends.

Super Soccer Stars: Are you ready to run, pass, and score? Super Soccer Stars is the ultimate summer destination for every soccer fan! Whether you're a beginner learning to kick or a seasoned pro looking to sharpen your game, this is the place to be.
