Logistical Questions

1. What is the location of Math Field Day?

The 2025 Math Field Day Event will be located at San Gabriel Valley High School, 801 S Ramona St, San Gabriel, CA 91776.

2. What is the schedule for Math Field Day?

3. How do I prepare for Math Field Day?

4. What is the cost for Math Field Day?

6. How do I register for Math Field Day?

7. What is the deadline for registration?

The deadline to register is April 1, 2024.

Registration Questions (Continued)

8. How many teams can I register?

Each district (with the exemption of LAUSD) is able to register one team per grade level. The district will complete one registration. In the registration form, the district is able to register one team for each grade level 4 - 11. It is not mandatory to have a team for each grade level.

9. How many students per team?

Each grade level team must have 4 participating students and 1 alternate. Alternates are ONLY able to attend Math Field Day if one of the team members is unable to attend on the day of the event.

10. What happens if a student participant is unable to attend the day of Math Field Day?

If there is an emergency and a student is unable to participate in Math Field Day, you will need to utilize the backup student. Teams will not be able to participate without the 4 students.

11. What grade levels can participate in Math Field Day?

Grade levels of 4th - 11th grade are able to participate in Math Field Day.

Other Type of Questions

12. How many chaperones do I need for Math Field Day?

You will need one chaperone per grade level team. The chaperoned will serve in any of the following appropriate roles:

- *Non-credentialed: Volunteer*
- *Credentialed: Coach or Scorer*

13. Do students get food during Math Field Day?

LACOE will only provide water to students. Coordinators and parents are encouraged to provide snacks for students at the end of the competition.

14. Are we allowed to wear school gear?

LACOE encourages school spirit, students are allowed to wear school gear or shirts to indicate the school of representation.
