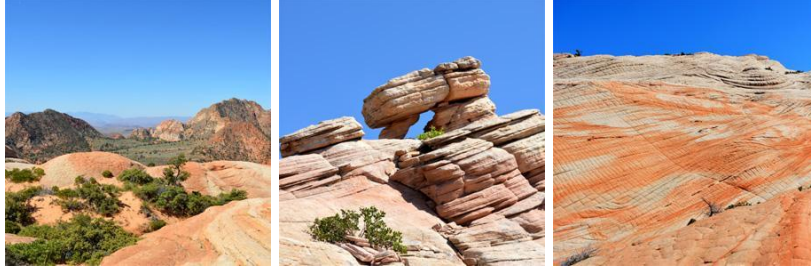


# **Yant Flat - Candy Cliffs on Saturday, October 19 at 8:00 AM**



**New Promise Hikers will visit the Candy Cliffs at Yant Flat on Saturday, October 19 at 8:00 AM. The Candy Cliffs offer crazy sandstone formations with color patterns that go in every direction. Rather than just bands and swirls of red, there are bands of yellow, white, red and orange. It is similar to The Wave, but near St. George!**

**If you'd like to go, meet at the Walmart Supercenter parking lot at 625 W Telegraph St. in Washington, Utah at 8:00 AM, at the north corner of the lot along Telegraph Road. Carpool to Yant Flat via Leeds. Of course, remember to bring at least half a gallon (2 liters) of water, comfortable shoes, snacks and maybe a lunch with you. Dress appropriately for the conditions and it is a good idea to layer your clothing so you can adjust to the changing temperatures as they occur.**

**Note: It is suggested that only SUVs and Jeeps go on this particular hike. (You can join someone else with an SUV or Jeep to make the trip when we meet at Walmart.) The dirt road to Yant Flat is reasonably OK up to the final mile. The final mile can get rather interesting, thus requiring higher clearance vehicles. **\*\*More info on road conditions shortly after I do the pre-hike\*\*** Please see the attachment below for more info about the hike.**
