Music majors must successfully complete a qualifying review (Sophomore Promotion) by the music department faculty at the end of the sophomore year in order to remain in the major.

Visual and Performing Arts scholarship students may be required to remain enrolled in applied lessons each semester of enrollment at the University as designated in their scholarship agreement.

³ A maximum of two ensembles may be taken for credit per semester. Visual and Performing Arts scholarship students are assigned an ensemble and may be required to be enrolled in an ensemble each semester as designated in their scholarship agreement.
