ADDITIONAL MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Music majors must attend 8 Music department-approved concerts and/or recitals each semester for a total of 64 before graduation.

Music majors must successfully complete a qualifying review (Sophomore Promotion) by the music department faculty at the end of the sophomore year in order to remain in the major.

¹ Piano Proficiency Exam may substitute for these courses.

² May choose from MUSC 001, 002, 003, 004, 005, 006, 007, 008, or 010. A minimum of four credits must be earned in the same applied area. Visual and Performing Arts scholarship students may be required to remain enrolled in applied lessons each semester of enrollment at the University as designated in their scholarship agreement.

³ A maximum of two ensembles may be taken for credit per semester. Visual and Performing Arts scholarship students are assigned an ensemble and may be required to be enrolled in an ensemble each semester as designated in their scholarship agreement.
