INPUT FROM STATE AND NATIONAL LWV ON TERM LIMITS: The consensus committee voted to support term limits for town councilors and school committee members and for the office of Council President. After the votes, the Town Charter Task Force was advised that there is a National LWV position opposing term limits that was also supported by LWVMA. The Task Force is in the process of conferring with both State and National about the applicability of the 1991 position to local leagues.
