

## July 2024

On New Year's Day, my NHK News app alerted me that a major earthquake had occurred in the Noto region of the Ishikawa Prefecture of Japan, on the west coast of Honshu (Japan's main island). A significant part of the coast was evacuated, including my extended family members who live in the adjacent Fukui Prefecture.

As some of you know, our family has been privileged to serve with different disaster relief ministries over the years, from the Great Tohoku earthquake and tsunami to the major quake in Kumamoto Prefecture. We again have that opportunity.

I'm now in process, serving as Associate Staff with Global Intercultural Services (GLINTS), which is the sending agency for our volunteer disaster relief work (more information at <a href="glints.org">glints.org</a>). I had the privilege of serving with GLINTS leaders, Levi and Diane Velasco, in the aftermath of Japan's Great Earthquake and Tsunami in 2011.

This year we're planning to head to the Noto region to help with established ministries who are currently serving in the damaged area. Our dates are from July 28 – August 8, 2024. We've a small team this year, since this is our first return to Japan since the pandemic. My 23-year-old son Peter and yours truly will be serving together.





We'll be doing whatever the recovering community needs. We have experience with cleanup, relocating residence to and from temporary housing, providing programs in temporary housing and childcare centers, among our other experiences. As this is a recovering disaster area, we're preparing for anything.
