6. Short listing of applications:

7. General Conditions :

Unemployed SC/ST candidates are entitled for 2nd class rail fare as per Govt. rules and the same will be reimbursed by post on submission of certificate of unemployment issued by Gazetted Officer.

(iii) For claiming age relaxation, the candidates should enclose self-attested copy of relevant certificate with application and produce original certificate in support of their claim on demand. OBC candidates are to produce attested copies of latest OBC certificates in the prescribed form issued by Competent Authority as prescribed vide OM No. 36012/22/93/Esstt. (SCT) dated 22 Oct 1993.
