<u>Publications/Newsletter/Handbook/flyers</u> - Love writing and editing? Want to hear the printed word sing? Like picture-taking and making things fit together, have you got a nose for journalism and reporting? This committee needs you! Our goal is to make everything we possibly can electronic media. Paper is wonderful but expensive. Hopefully members can print their newsletters etc. at their own site if they wish to have paper (hard copy) - but we are leaning toward digital. (we haven't got a printing budget).

<u>Elections/Nominating Committee</u> - Officer positions are slated to last 2-years and terms of various officers are staggered, so that the Board of Directors never has 100% turnover in just 1-year and the old hands can help the newly elected orientate. A committee to find who the replacement officers should be, how best to conduct the elections, and to find the changes needed to have the Club run superbly -- maybe this is where you want to volunteer!
