The abstract should only be typed in one paragraph and one-column format.

In the scientific article format, it is not permitted to reflect on the literature as in research reports, but is realized in the form of a review of previous literature (state of the art) to show the scientific novelty of the article (empirical problems, theoretical problems, normative problems).

## **HASIL DAN PEMBAHASAN**

Results and discussion contain research findings and discussion. Write down the findings obtained from the results of the research that has been carried out and must be supported by adequate data. Research results and findings must be able to answer the research questions or hypotheses in the introduction.

## **KESIMPULAN**

The closing contains conclusions and suggestions. Conclusions describe the answer to the hypothesis and/or research objectives or findings obtained. The conclusion does not contain a repetition of the results and discussion, but rather a summary of the findings as expected in the objective or hypothesis. Suggestions present things that will be done related to further ideas from the research

## **DAFTAR PUSTAKA**

All references referred to in the text of the article must be listed in the Bibliography section. The bibliography must contain reference libraries originating from primary sources (scientific journals and amounting to a minimum of 80% of the entire bibliography) published in the last 10 (ten) years. Each article contains at least 13 (ten) references.

Writing a bibliography should use a reference management application such as Mendeley. The writing format used in *Dinamika Governance: Jurnal Ilmu Administrasi Negara* is in accordance with the APA 7th Edition (American Psychological Association) format. References are not separated between journals, books, etc.

2. The manuscript is prepared in a A4 paper, single-sided, and single line spacing format. A new paragraph should start 5 characters from the left margin, using 12-size, and 1.15 line-spacing with after 6 pt and before 6 pt, Times-new-romans font type, around 5000-6000 words including figures, tables and references.
3. The manuscript is written in English or Indonesia.
4. The title is written using capital letters only at first word or special name (example: location name), 14 font size, center position.

5. The manuscript should be between 10 to 13 pages long.
6. References are required to use Mendeley APA 7th Edition. Minimum 15 References.
7. References should be those of the last ten years publication (>80%), except for key references (80%). Referring to any textbook should be minimized (<20%), Include at least 3 references from Jurnal **Dinamika Governance**.
8. Plagiarism results must demonstrate a similarity score of no more than 25%. Primary sources no more 3%. Otherwise the manuscript must be revised.
