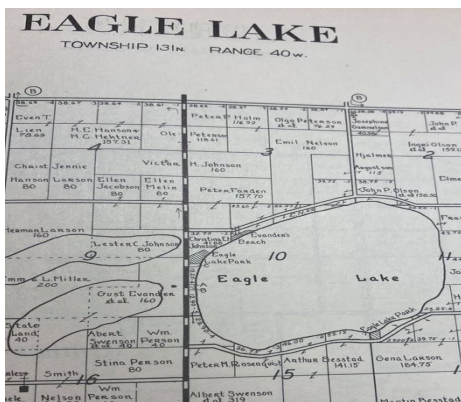
Started around 1927 at 📍 Eagle Lake Public Access by the Park Region Council

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Girl Scout camp was also held at Eagle Lake in 1927. Miss Kennedy of the Red Cross taught swimming.



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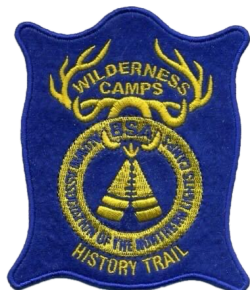

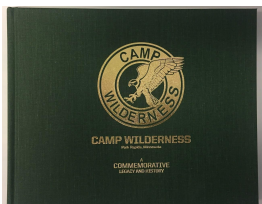

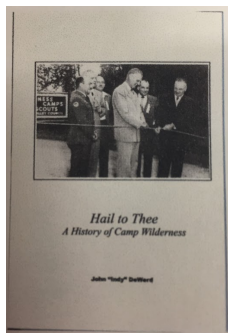
