Un Petit Coup Zine Guidelines

Basic Information (what to know before you apply):

- This zine is all Loustat, all the time focused on AMC's IWTV adaptation, and the relationship between Louis and Lestat. There is no specific time period associated with the zine, and we hope to host a variety of Loustat-era's in our pages, including AU's.
- This zine is **18+ only** no exceptions. You must be 18 or above to participate/contrivite to this project.
- We are seeking: 25 page artists (who may create single pages, double page spreads, or two separate page illustrations), 5-6 authors (who may create ficlets of under 2k words, short fan fiction of 2-5k words, or other writing materials such as poetry), 5-6 merch artists (who may create a keychain, print? Sticker, button, digital merch, or another item of choice) and 1 Cover Artist.
 - Current zine specs include: 1 Royal Size perfect bound Zine with ~60+ full color pages, 1 2-3" acrylic charm, 3 1.5-2.5" stickers, 1 2-2.5" button badge, 2 4x6" prints (or photocards), and 1 more merch item of choice. Additional digital merchandise to be added.
- This zines production period is ~1.5 month you can find a predicted schedule below. Note that this is a shorter production period than many zine projects, but it is part of UPC's goal to remain small, curated and affordable. In an effort to continue the trend of convenience, the goal is to produce this zine in a "short" time period to ensure its success. extensions may be granted on a case by case basis, but please intend to follow the posted schedule.
- UPC is a charity zine which means any proceeds raised outside of production will be donated to a charity of contributor choice. Because of this, there are currently no plans for **contributor compensation**.
 - o Ideally, we will be able to offer contributors copies of the zine at no cost (aside from shipping), but this is highly dependent on the raised funds. Please do not join if you are banking on a free copy off the bat - it's part of our goal to at least get contributors their work, but until we start funding, its unconfirmed. Worst case scenario, we will offer contributors zines at production cost rather than retail.
- Communication for this zine will be primarily through discord. If you do not utilize
 discord, you must be willing to create an account to participate. Major deadlines will also
 receive email reminders/correspondence.
- This zine will utilize **Backerkit** to raise funds. This guarantees that if funding goals are not reached, no customers are charged and there is no refund-issue.
- Please refrain from posting any of your work for UPC zine until the designated drop date

 this keeps work largely exclusive to purchasers until they receive their product. We will
 have a preview period where a portion of your work may be used for promotional
 purposes.

- UPC has a commitment to the accurate and appropriate depiction of POC characters. This will be taken into account during the application period.
- The zine is 18+, but not NSFW. Some work may feature suggestive themes, and a healthy dose of Vampire Chronicles Gore, as is a keystone of Ricean vampires, but there will be no full nudity or explicitly sexual content within this zine (this is due to printing restrictions). Suggestive material will be permitted (as is the nature of these wretched creatures!). We just have to walk the line of subjectivity!
- AU Content may be featured in this zine, but the goal is to create a cohesive artbook
 without too much outlandish material if you're creating AU content for the zine, please
 try to keep it thematically relevant.
- Charity is TBD, to be voted on by contributors.

Submission Guidelines:

- Please make sure all of your links are completely accessible. I will NOT reach out to seek permission if you did not adjust your files.
- Accepted Example sources: google drive, drop box, other portfolio website. Please do not submit a link to your social media here.
- You may apply for more than one contributor position please be sure to mark in the
 designated section that you are applying for multiple positions AND submit forms to ALL
 of the relevant channels.
- You MAY be accepted for more than one position.
- IWTV is not required in your samples, but highly preferred. In addition for artists, it
 would be a good idea to submit artwork involving non-white figures alongside anything
 else you have. UPC is committed to accurate appropriate depictions of people of
 color. This is crucial.
- **For Writers:** please be mindful of submitted word count in your applications I am one person with only a few days to sift through work and assess. Ficlets or one shots are preferred, or choose an excerpt from a longer piece to submit.
- **For Merch Artists:** if posssible, please submit at least one actual photo of merchandise you've created.
- Be sure to submit work that accurately reflects what your potential submission could look like - if you operate with more than one writing or art style, that's absolutely okay, but make sure you submit a variety of work to reflect your range in that case.
- Don't feel married to your submitted concepts this won't largely affect your application, but will help us try to avoid too many overlapping concepts in the final zine.

• Make sure your work is **appropriately tagged**. you **may** submit NSFW work as part of your application so long as it's appropriately tagged!

Frequently Asked Questions:

- Where will this zine be fulfilled?
 - o Oregon, USA.
- Will international orders be available?
 - So long as we are able to ship outside the US, absolutely. Please be mindful about the state of the USA at the moment, and offer grace if something changes.
- Why is there a minimum age requirement?
 - Anne Rice's content is not child-friendly. It's simple as that! Hypocritical to say as
 I was under 10 when I walked into the world of TVC, but this is a curated online
 space and for everyone's safety and comfort, this zine is going to be 18+.
- How are contributors selected?
 - There's no way to get around it: it's subjective, and any zine who tells you otherwise is lying. However, I am committed to choosing a variety of skills and styles to be showcased in this project. Largely, I will be assessing your composition, color, thematic usage, and ability to depict pre-existing characters.
- Will there be rejection emails as well as acceptance?
 - My goal is to make sure anyone who applied received an answer. I cannot offer individual feedback at this time, but you should absolutely get an email another way.
- What if I cannot complete my piece?
 - In some cases, an extension may be allowed. I ask that if you must leave the project that you do it sooner than later so I can bring in a pinch-hitter.
- Who can I contact with more questions?
