- Burnt sienna
- Raw umber

ALL STUDENTS - other materials you will need:

- Paint rags, many (t-shirt material) FABRIC not paper towels
- Sketchbook, at least 9 x 12 inches
- Drawing instruments of your choice
- Palette there are many types to choose from, start with disposable and a Masterson covered box
- Color Wheel
- Grev Scale Value Chart
- Small container of Gesso
- Brushes (bristle or synthetic) range of sizes, long handle brush. There is little uniformity between brush brands. You want some small and some larger.
 - -- Bright #8, 12
 - -- Filbert #2, 4, 6, 10, 12
 - -- Flat #10, 12
 - -- Round #2, 4, 8, 12

ACRYLIC PAINTERS:

- Canvas boards, stretched canvases, or Bristol paper
- Spray Bottle, small
- Airbrush medium
- A container for water

OIL PAINTERS:

- Canvas boards, stretched canvases
- Silver Brush Black Goat Silver Mop Brush, 1/2"
- Linseed oil
- Turpenoid (NOT TURPENOID NATURAL) or any low-odor solvent
- Two glass jars with tops
