**Drop Off**

- Students will only be able to be dropped off **10 minutes before class is to begin.**
- They will not be able to linger in the lobby of the school, but will be directed to go straight to their classroom or wait in the first floor hallway.

**Pick Up**

- You will only be able to pick up your student by parking and walking up to the school to wait for your child.

**Family Masses**

  - We encourage all family members to attend (this includes grandparents & friends)
- There are FOUR times we will offer Masses on weeks when we do not have classes scheduled.
