TOURNAMENT DATES AND SITES:

The selection of sectional and district tournament sites for all divisions have been posted to the Central District website (https://www.ohsaa.org/Central-Sports-Tournaments/Golf-Girls).

OHSAA TOURNAMENT ENTRY:

Athletic Directors must indicate in myOHSAA their school's intent to participate in OHSAA girls golf tournament and coaches must meet all tournament participation requirements. Entry of a team or individuals must be properly indicated in myOHSAA.

TOURNAMENT SEEDING:

All participating schools (teams and individuals) must submit their tournament seeding information prior to **9:00 a.m. on Friday, September 15, 2023.** Schools that do not submit the required seeding information prior to the deadline may incur a penalty.

SEE SEEDING INSTRUCTIONS ARE BELOW

- Coaches of teams (a team is defined as four or more participants from the same school) must submit their team's season-to-date win/loss record, the team's nine-hole scoring average.
- Coaches of individual participants (three or less participants from the same school) must submit their individual(s) name, grade level and nine-hole scoring average.

Nine-hole scoring average: In an attempt to have consistency in the calculation of a team's nine-hole scoring average, please use the following method: add all your team's match scoring totals and divide by the number of nine hole matches you played. If you play 18-hole matches, use your 18-hole team total and count the match as two when determining the number of nine hole matches you played. For example, if you play seven matches of nine holes and eight matches of 18 holes, you divide your team scoring total by 23 (7+16) to get your nine-hole average.

TOURNAMENT DRAW MEETINGS

Individuals - Coaches of individual tournament participants will not seed and do not have to attend the draw meeting. Individual participants will be assigned to a sectional tournament site and tee times by Larry Morris, Tournament Manager. Coaches of individuals must view their participant's assigned tournament site and tee time on Tuesday, September 19. Tee times will be published on the Central District web site (https://www.ohsaa.org/Central-Sports-Tournaments/Golf-Girls).

Note: No other notification will be sent to coaches of individuals.

Teams – Schools competing as a team **must seed on-line** and **attend** their assigned **VIRTUAL** draw meeting. Complete seeding instructions are below. Coaches have from 3:00 p.m. on Friday, September 15 to 12:00 noon Saturday, September 17 to

complete the seeding procedures. If you have any questions during the seeding process, contact Bruce Gerber at 614-554-5124.

Schools with teams that do not submit the required seeding ballot prior to the deadline may incur a penalty.

Draw Meeting for Teams – Teams will draw for tournament sites and tee times VIRTUALLY using Microsoft Teams on Sunday, September 17. **Participation in this meeting is mandatory.** Links to the meeting will be provided to each coach during the seeding process and sent via email to the address submitted during the seeding process.
